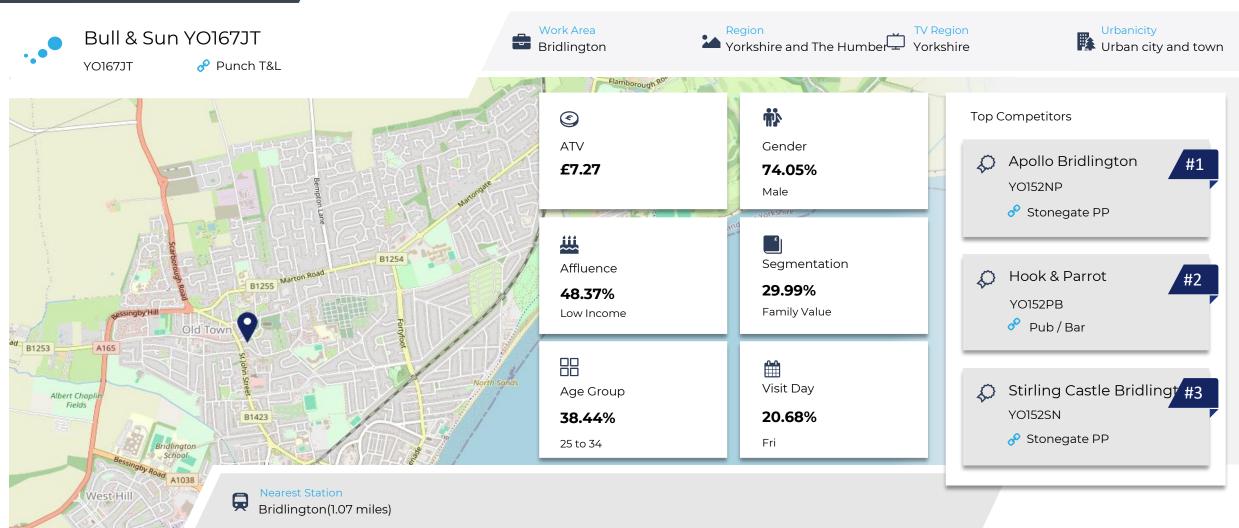

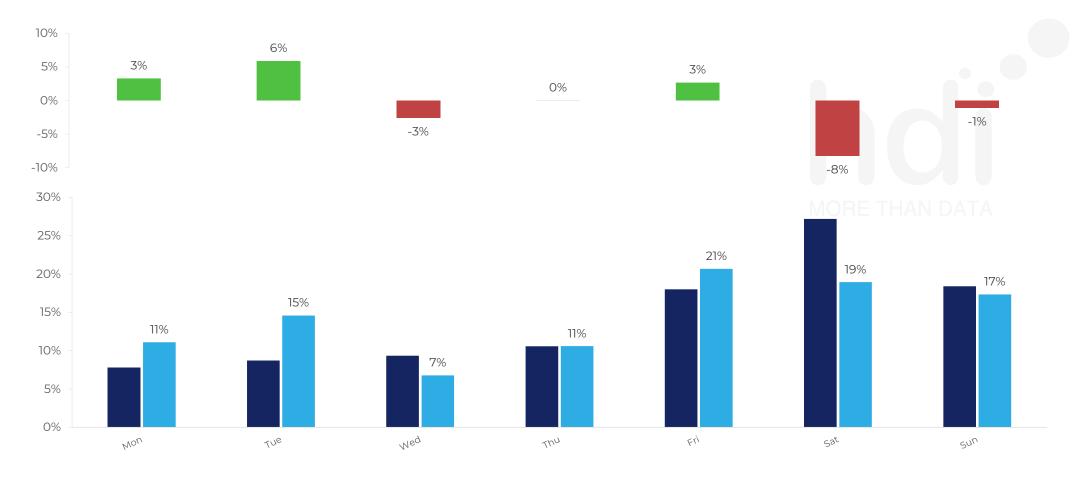




Spend by Weekpart

% of spend for Bull & Sun YO167JT and 106 Chains in 3 Miles from 13/12/2023 - 04/06/2025 split by Day of Week

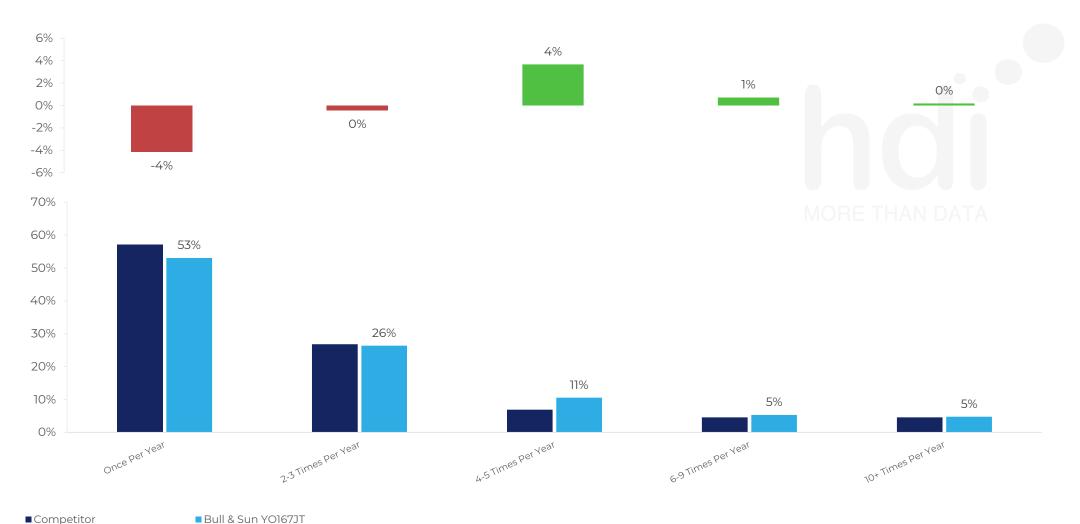

How frequently per year do customers visit Bull & Sun YO167JT versus its competitors?

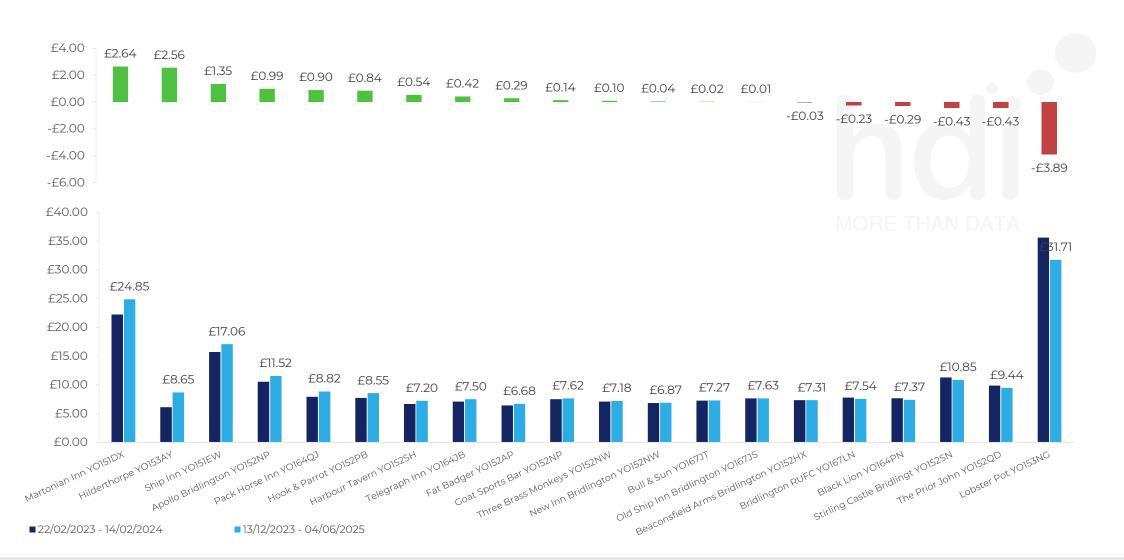

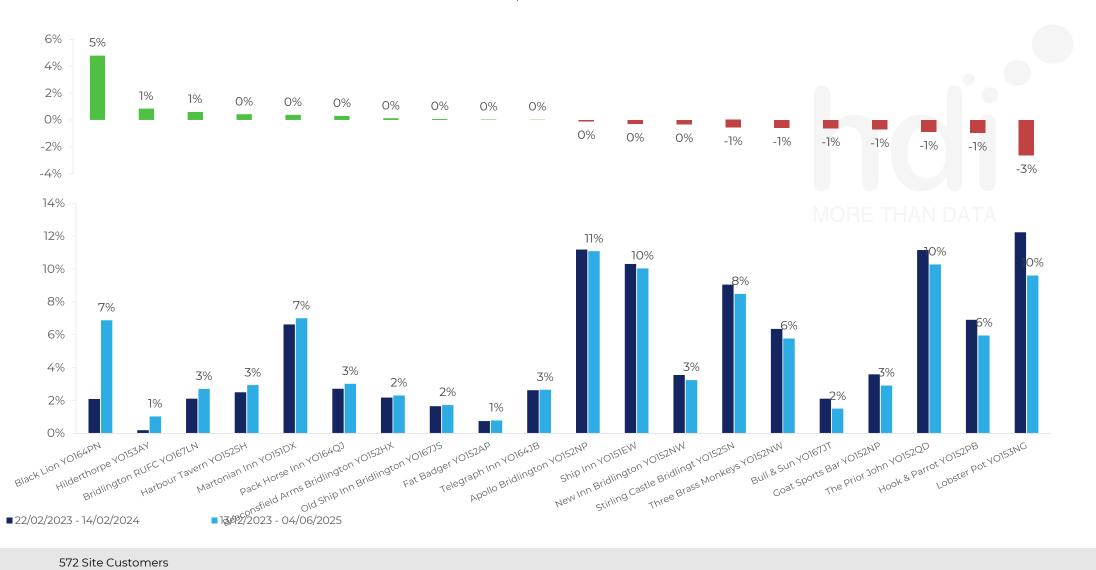
How has ATV changed between two date ranges?

% of market share spend for Bull & Sun YO167JT and 106 Chains in 3 Miles from 13/12/2023 - 04/06/2025

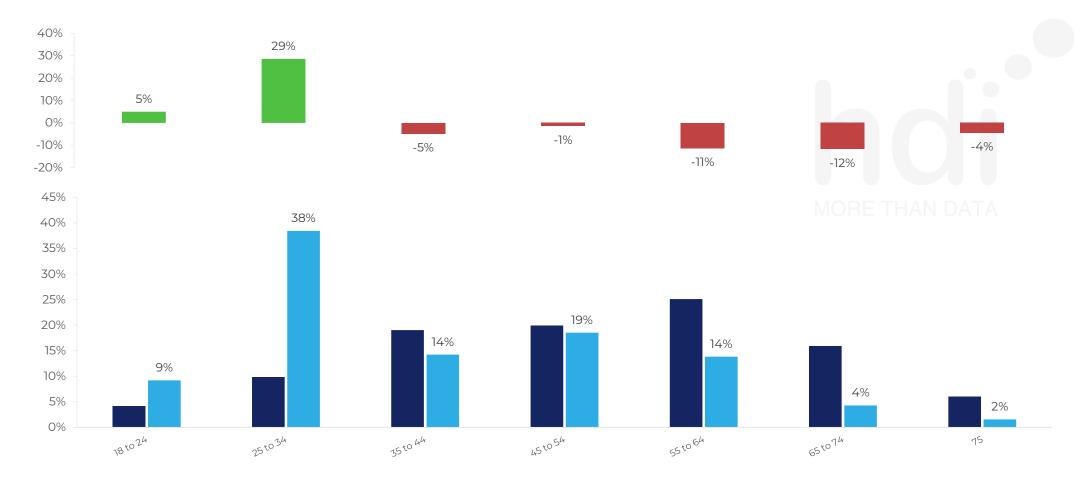






How does the age profile of customers who visit Bull & Sun YO167JT compare versus its competitors?

% of spend for Bull & Sun YO167JT and 106 Chains in 3 Miles from 13/12/2023 - 04/06/2025 split by Age Range



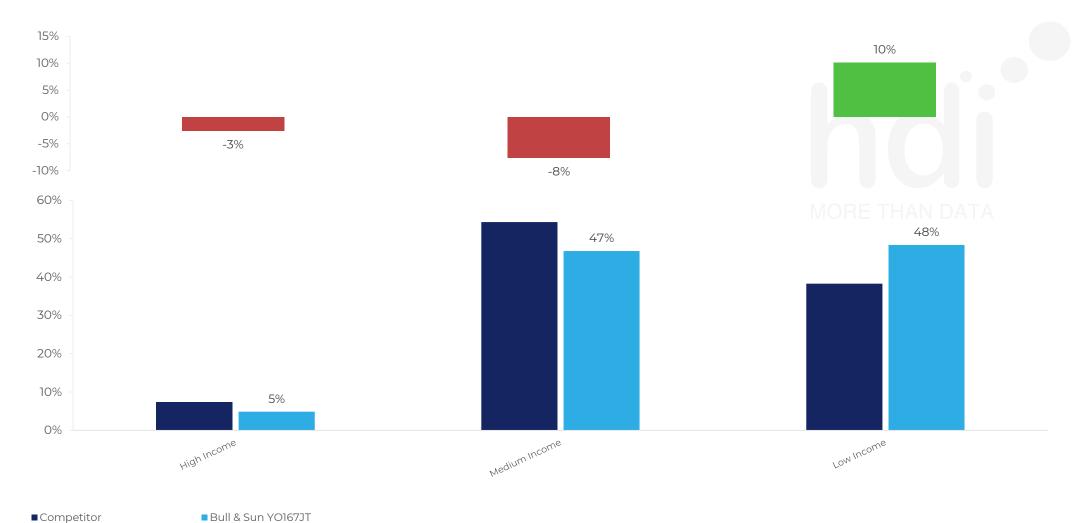

% of spend for Bull & Sun YO167JT and 106 Chains in 3 Miles from 13/12/2023 - 04/06/2025 split by Affluence



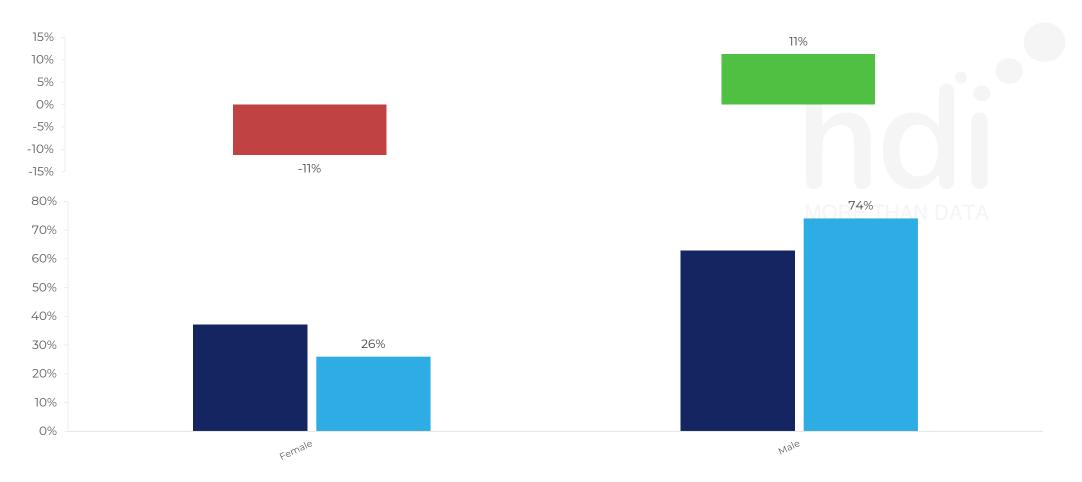

SEGMENT SNAPSHOTS



1 - Family Familiar

- Value-oriented family groups who are particularly prevalent in the Midlands and the North.
- These customers more regularly visit McDonalds or Nandos or order Just Eat but do occasionally use suburban pubs for eating - particularly on a Sunday.
- Great value is essential with menu preferences for grilled meat, the kids menu and soft drinks.



5 - METRO SOPHISTICATES

- Metro Sophisticates are younger, more affluent guests often found in and around larger cities.
- These customers favour more premium venues and tend to make healthier, more ethical choices.
- Living active lives, Metro Sophisticates will choose more premium brands such as Neck Oil, Fever Tree and Bombay Sapphire. They're interested in vegetarian / vegan menu options.



2 - Occasional & Local

- Occasional & Local are lower frequency habitual drink-led customers.
- These value-oriented customers typically drink in lower priced suburban locations midweek.
- Occasional & Local favour recognised mainstream drinks brands such as Carling, Fosters, John Smiths or Smirnoff.



6 - YOUNG & CONNECTED

- Young & Connected customers are typically younger, less affluent customers. They favour branded businesses and have high online usage
- They tend to use lower-priced pubs in high street locations with a preference for spirits, cocktails, shots and burgers in Punch sites.
- Young & Connected customers are responsive to events in the pub, e.g. live sport, bank holidays.



3 - Mid-week Seniors

- Mid-week Grey Social customers are older customers who prefer a peaceful pub - typically visiting midweek daytime and often avoiding busy
- These customers are of varying affluence.
- They prefer classic menu items such as fish and chips and hunters chicken with a lean towards cask ale, hot drinks and wines.



7 - Bubbly Weekenders

- Bubbly Weekenders are slightly health-conscious younger customers who confine their pub use to high street venues at the weekend.
- Disproportionately female, Bubbly Weekenders favour spirits, cocktails and shots when in Punch
- o If eating, they've an interest in vegetarian / vegan dishes and have a preference for chicken burgers.



- Upmarket Diners are affluent, older quests who tend to visit higher-priced rural pubs during the daytime (often Sunday) for food.
- These active customers make healthy, ethical choices and aren't overly price conscious.
- When with Punch, Upmarket Diners are more likely to buy a roast or a special. If buying drinks, they lean towards wine, hot drinks and softs.

4 - PART OF THE PUB

- Part of the Pub customers are very habitual value
- They drink in their local pub during the week with brands such as Bud. Smirnoff and Jamesons.
- These customers are more likely to visit betting shops, off licences and watch live football.





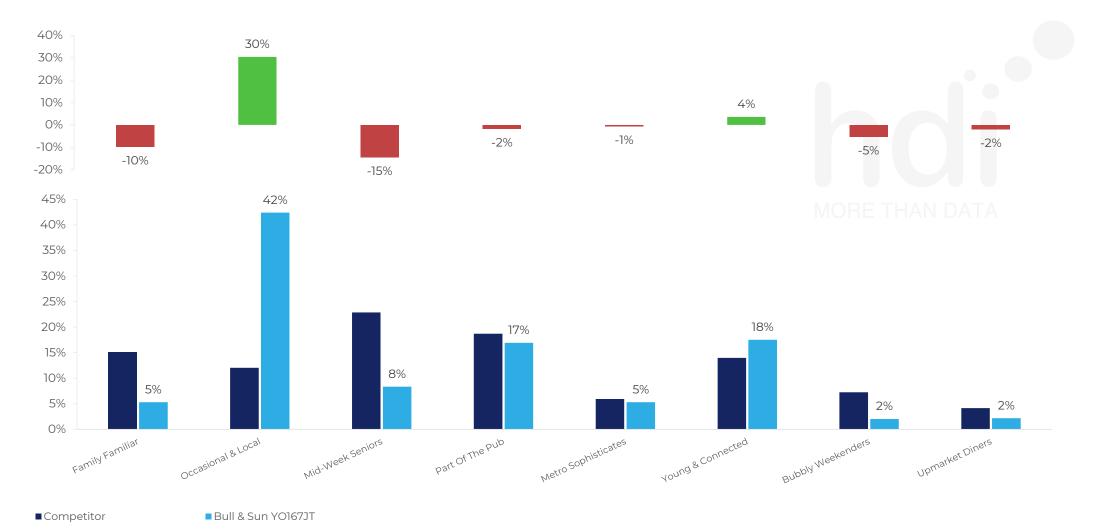

% of spend for Bull & Sun YO167JT and 106 Chains in 3 Miles from 13/12/2023 - 04/06/2025 split by Segment



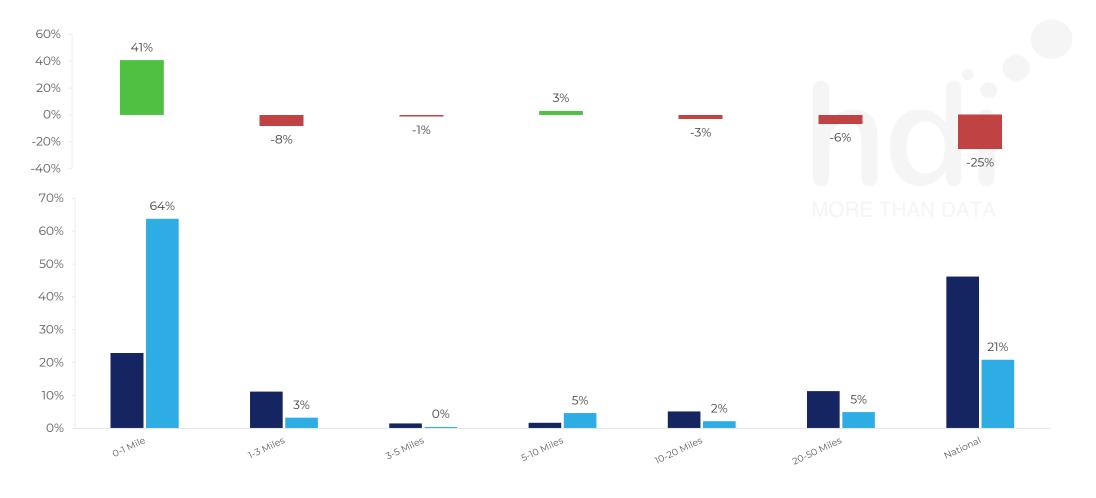

% of spend for Bull & Sun YO167JT and 106 Chains in 3 Miles from 13/12/2023 - 04/06/2025 split by Distance travelled





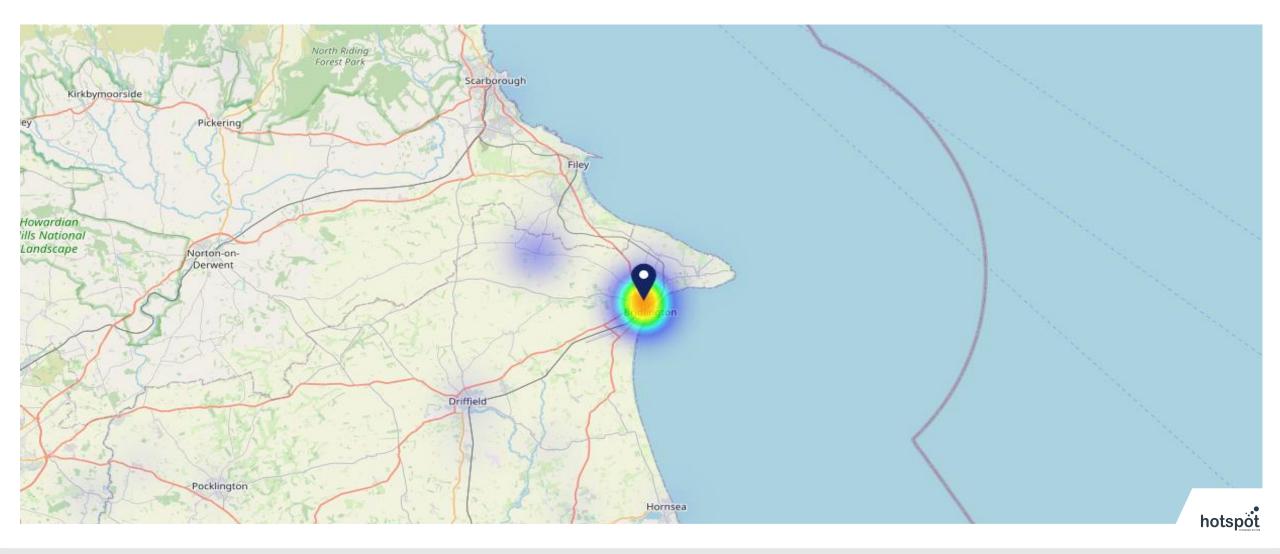

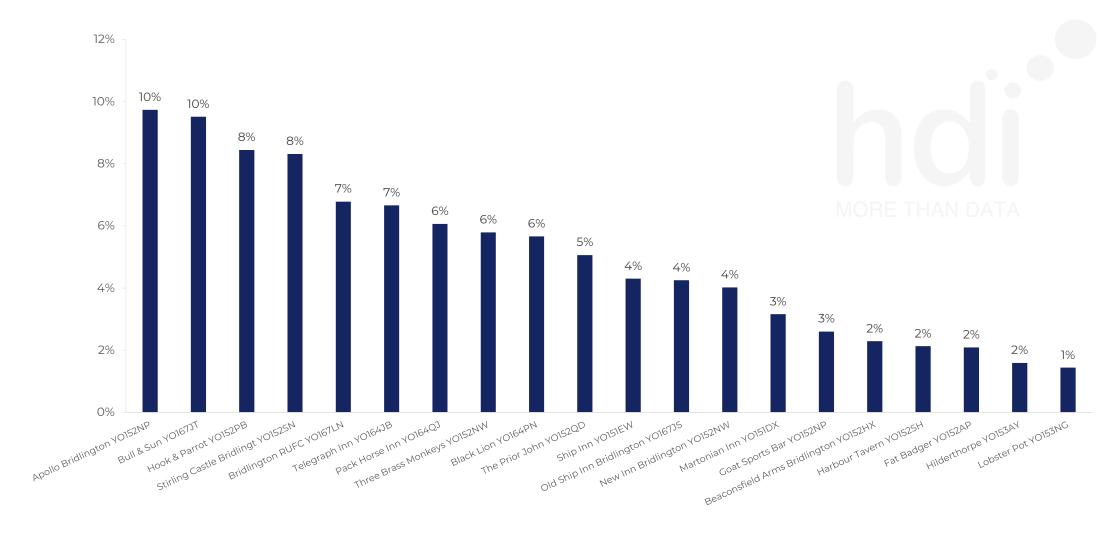

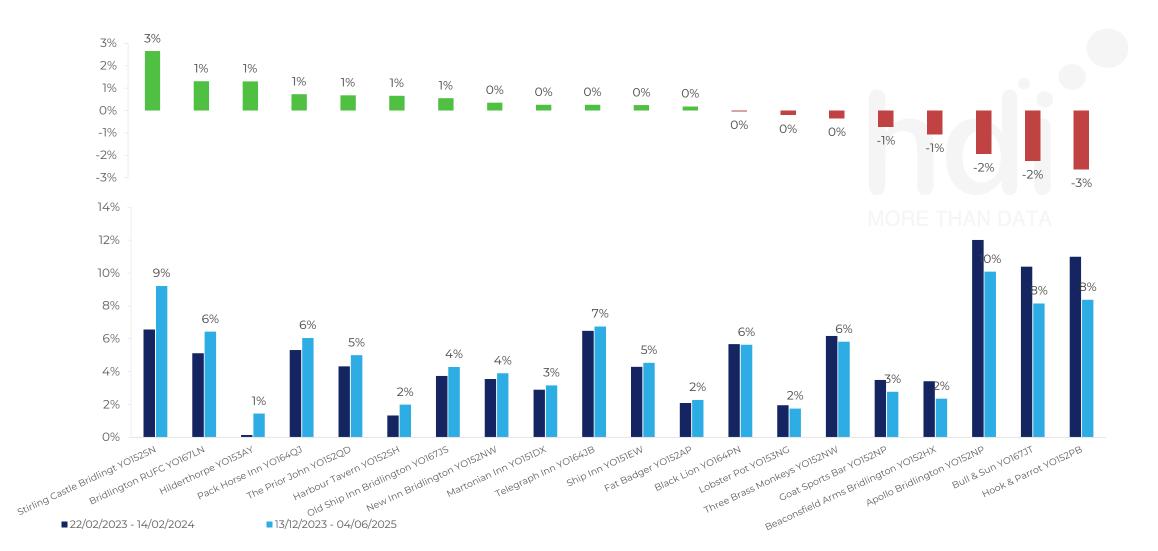






Share of Wallet Change

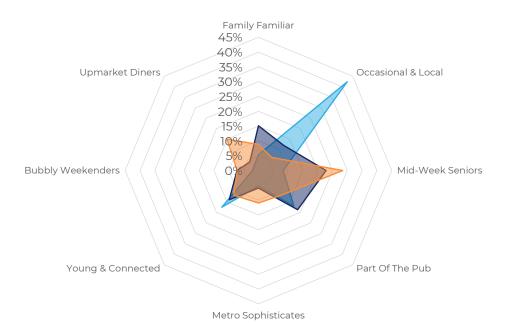
